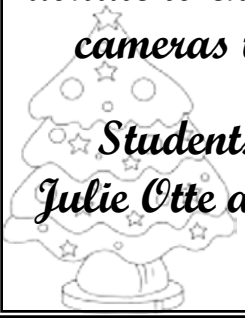
Happy Thanksgiving from the Staff of Arbor Greene!

Landscaping

November Landscape Schedule other than mowing & trimming

Nov 5-10: Complete annual flower plantings. Install mulch in planter beds. Mow pond banks.

Nov 12-17: Complete mulch installation. Treat all turf areas for weeds fertilize all shrubs.

Nov 19-24: Mow pond banks. Thanksgiving Holiday.

Nov 26-30: Retreat turf for any remaining weeds. Trim Oak trees from sidewalks and raise canopies for at least 10 feet clearance.

Did you Know?

- ◆ **We have Water Use Restrictions.** The City of Tampa Water Use Restrictions imposed May 4, 2006 are still in force. Watering with reclaimed water is not restricted. However, unlike Hunters Greene and Tampa Palms, Arbor Greene does not use reclaimed water for irrigation of landscaping in common areas within the community. Therefore, Arbor Greene may not water as often or as much as communities that use reclaimed water. Arbor Greene is restricted to irrigation watering one time per week under the current water restrictions.
- ◆ **Why the Water Fountain at Enclave and Estuary Circle is not working?** The water fountain is operational but cannot be used due to current water use restrictions. Outdoor aesthetic uses of water such as decorative fountains and features are prohibited. Lakes and ponds that use a fountain, such as the fountain at the entrance to Arbor Greene, are used for recirculation and necessary to provide water quality benefits are not restricted. - ◆ **The Fitness Pool cover** will begin to be used to cover the pool when the water temperature begins to drop below 82 degrees and we begin to heat the pool water. Normally this temperature drop occurs in late October or early November. When we begin to put the pool cover on the pool, the pool will open an hour later and close an hour earlier.
- ◆ **Our Camera Surveillance System** has assisted the City of Tampa Police in the investigation of two separate incidents in Arbor Greene that were successfully completed.
- ◆ **The City of Tampa Police** regularly patrols the streets in Arbor Greene. Numerous traffic citations have been written for excessive speed. Please observe the posted speed limit of 30MPH in Arbor Greene.
- ◆ **If you have a concern about your neighbor's lawn** or other neighbor issues, you should call the Homeowners Association (HOA) at 994-4330.
- ◆ A **Streetlight check is made monthly** by your Arbor Greene maintenance team. If your streetlight is not working, call Gary Smith at 928-9226 and it will be scheduled for repair as soon as possible.
- ◆ If you **want to paint your house**, install a fence or add a solar pool heating system, you must complete an Alteration Application form and submit it to the Homeowners Association for approval. Call Debra Cappelli, 994-4330 for more information.
- ◆ **We have new and expanded hours for the Community Center:** The new Community Center operating hours are expanded as follows:
 - Saturday from 8:00am to 10:00pm (previously 6:00pm)
 - Sunday from 10:00am to 8:00pm (previously 6:00pm)
 - Monday-Friday hours have not changed and are 6am-10pm

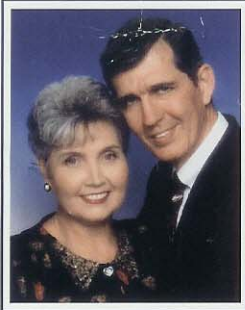

Recipe Corner

Thanksgiving Day Sweet Potato Pie

Filling:

2 large sweet potatoes

2 eggs

2 egg yolks

2/3 cup sugar

1/2 teaspoon salt

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon

1/4 teaspoon ground ginger or 1 teaspoon finely grated fresh ginger

1/4 teaspoon freshly grated nutmeg

1 1/4 cups light cream or half-and-half

Prepare and chill the dough.

Bake sweet potatoes for 1 hour at 350 degrees, or until soft. Cool, peel and pour in the food processor.

Preheat oven to 350 degrees and set a rack in the lowest level. For the bottom crust, lightly flour the work surface and the dough and roll it to a 12-inch disk. Fold the dough in half and place it in the pan; unfold the dough and press it firmly into the pan. Trim away all but 1/2-inch excess dough at edge of pan. Fold dough under and flute edge. For the filling, scrape pumpkin into a bowl and whisk in eggs and yolks. Whisk in remaining ingredients in order, whisking smooth between each addition. Pour the filling into the prepared pie crust.

Bake the pie for about 1 hour, until the crust is baked through and the filling is set. Cool the pie on a rack.
